Toshinari Kunieda was named Senior Vice President in June 2007 while concurrently serving as Managing Director of the Global Business Department, a post he has held since July 2005.

His previous post was Executive Director of the Global Business Department, to which he was appointed in July 2003 when he moved to NTT DoCoMo from Nippon Telegraph and Telephone Corp. (NTT), DoCoMo's parent company.

At NTT, Mr. Kunieda held several posts involving international affairs, including General Manager of the International Procurement Office (July 2001 to March 2003). His tenure also included a posting to The World Bank in Washington D.C. (February 1994 to March 1997); as a Private Sector Development Specialist, he participated in World Bank projects related to privatization of national telecommunications operators in Bulgaria, Romania, the Ukraine, Lebanon, Sri Lanka and Indonesia.

He entered NTT Public Corporation in April 1978, after graduating from the University of Tokyo with a bachelor's degree in Electronics Engineering. He earned a master's degree of Science in Engineering Management from Stanford University in June 1983. Mr. Kunieda was born on August 31, 1954.
